All members of the academic staff, including research only staff, are invited to apply for the 2009 Faculty of Pharmacy Equipment Grants.

Grants for pieces of equipment that are less than \$5,000 will require a 25% contribution from the applicant. Grants for pieces of equipment that are more than \$5,000 will require a 50% contribution from the applicant. **Applications to purchase equipment or to lease large equipment (grant will be for one year only) will be considered.**

Please complete the form below. You will need to attach a current quotation, and a justification for the purchase of the equipment (maximum of one A4 page) by **Friday April 17th 2009** (no late applications will be considered). Monies allocated from this application must be spent by **31st September 2009**.

Once completed, return this application form to the Research Services Officer (research@pharm.usyd.edu.au)

The Research Committee will rank applications based on the following criteria:

- A brief justification;
- A financial contribution by the applicant;
- Purchase of the equipment is strategic, and will open up new avenues of research for the Faculty
- If the equipment is available for multiple staff members (please note that requests for equipment by one staff member will also be considered)
- Evidence that seed funding has already been obtained from external funding organizations (please note that we cannot support applications where the applicant plans to obtain the 25% or 50% contribution from future grant applications)
