Dr Lorraine Smith

Dr Lorraine Smith is a Registered Psychologist with 20 years experience in the treatment and management of the psychological aspects of living with chronic illness. Prior to joining the Faculty of Pharmacy at Sydney University she worked in the Faculty of Nursing, tutoring and lecturing in health psychology and communications, as well as running a private practice specialising in health psychology. Her work in the Faculty of Pharmacy has involved research and teaching in the psychosocial aspects of patient behaviour. Dr Smith is currently researching adolescents' self-management of Type 1 Diabetes, and is involved in other projects relating to patient self-management of chronic illness in the pharmacy practice setting. She has brought to the Pharmacy Practice Group at the University of Sydney expertise on the psychosocial aspects of patient self-management, and healthcare provider communications skills. This expertise has extended the boundaries of pharmacy research in Australia and has provided the type of input not normally available to such projects.
